CHOOSING YOUR GIFT

Gifts in Wills are a personal choice that allow you to continue supporting the people and causes you care about for years to come. If you choose to leave a gift to Farm Africa in your Will, whether big or small, you can help us reach more farmers and build a more prosperous future for communities in rural Africa.

Here are a few different ways you can leave a gift to Farm Africa in your Will:

A PERCENTAGE OF YOUR ESTATE

This is called a 'residuary gift', because after ensuring your loved ones receive everything you want to leave to them, the remainder of your estate is called the 'residue'.

A CASH GIFT

You can choose to leave a specific amount of money; this is called a 'pecuniary' gift. Please remember that in time inflation could reduce the value of a cash gift, so you might want to revise your donation from time to time.

A REVERSIONARY GIFT

This is a gift you leave to someone to have during their lifetime; then, after their passing, that same gift goes on to someone else. For instance, you could leave property to a relative, which then after they have passed, would be given to Farm Africa. Please do speak with your solicitor if you wish to leave a reversionary gift.

SUGGESTED WORDING FOR YOUR WILL

FOR LEAVING A PERCENTAGE SHARE OF YOUR ESTATE:

"I give a (words and figures) % share of the residue of my estate to..." (please use the Farm Africa wording below)

FOR LEAVING A CASH GIFT:

"I give the sum of £ (words and figures) to..." (please use the wording below)

FARM AFRICA WORDING:

Farm Africa, 3-5 Bleeding Heart Yard, London EC1N 8SJ, registered charity number 326901, to be used for its general charitable purposes and I declare that the receipt of their Treasurer or other proper officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge.

We always advise you to consult a solicitor when making or amending your Will.

YOUR QUESTIONS, ANSWERED

How do I include Farm Africa in my Will?

If you'd like to include Farm Africa in your Will, we suggest you visit a qualified solicitor. To ensure your gift is used in the way you would wish, we have written a suggested legal wording for you to share with your solicitor and use when writing your Will. You can find our suggested wording on page 5.

I already have a Will; how do I change it?

You can ask your solicitor to add a codicil (the legal term for an amendment) to include Farm Africa in an existing Will. We can provide you with a simple Codicil form for this purpose.

What do I do once I've left a legacy to Farm Africa?

You don't need to do anything else, but it is very helpful if you get in touch to let us know. You can call us on **020 7430 0440** or email **remember@farmafrica.org**. Knowing that you plan to leave us a gift in your Will helps us to prepare for the future and keep you informed about our work, should you so wish. We'd also like the chance to say thank you!

What happens if I change my mind?

You are free to change your mind at any time! Letting us know you plan to leave a gift in your Will to Farm Africa doesn't commit you to doing so. It would be very helpful if you let us know, as well as your solicitor, should you change your mind.

What if I don't have a large gift to leave?

Big or small, any gift that you leave to Farm Africa will help families in rural Africa to thrive for generations to come.
