PURPOSE OF THE ROLE

Farm Africa has a highly skilled and expert External Relations team that works to deliver our ambitious fundraising strategy and raise the profile of our important work.

As part of the External Relations team, the Trust & Philanthropy Manager plays a key role in delivering the fundraising strategy through aligned messaging and campaigns, prospecting, and managing relationships with key donors to drive growth.

The Trust & Philanthropy Manager will develop and execute fundraising plans that grow philanthropic income, which involves supporting our major donor fundraising and overseeing a portfolio of Trust donors.

In this role, you will work closely with the Head of Partnerships and the Head of Philanthropy to cultivate donor relationships and secure income. You will also play a critical role in planning and delivering funding applications and cross-audience cultivation events.

The ideal candidate is a relationship builder, creative thinker, and skilled communicator who thrives in a mission-driven environment.

KEY TASKS & RESPONSIBILITIES

Planning

Develop plans to identify and cultivate relationships with donors.

- Develop and deliver donor prospecting activities that identify donors whose personal values or philanthropic objectives align with the scale and ambition of Farm Africa's work.
- Develop outreach and cultivation plans to convert those prospects into donors with a particular focus on relationships with the potential to generate mid to large-value, sustainable, multi-year funding

Stewardship

Oversee donor recognition and stewardship activities to ensure a high level of donor satisfaction and retention, though:

- Working with the Head of Philanthropy, support the pipeline and delivery of stewardship activities for major donors and philanthropic foundations
- Developing and implementing annual plans to steward and grow our portfolio of trust donors
- Developing compelling funding applications that align with agreed priorities and themes, with a particular focus on generating unrestricted income
- Create and submit applications to secure co-funding and match income, liaising with Farm Africa's programme funding and country programme teams as necessary
- Maintain timely and accurate reporting (narrative and financial) as required.

Managing Information

Manage information effectively to ensure Farm Africa complies with data protection and maximises opportunities with donors.

- Monitor, manage and maintain systems to track pipelines and income
- Work closely with teams across the organisation to maximise funding opportunities by sharing and exchanging information for project proposals and reports
- Keep up to date with fundraising and philanthropy trends and best practice.
