JOB TITLE: Project Agronomist – 1 position

PURPOSE OF THE ROLE

Farm Africa is implementing the *Farm to Market Alliance* (FtMA) project in the Singida, Manyara, and Morogoro regions. Farm Africa is looking to recruit Agronomist to take the lead delivering demand-driven advisory services to the farmers through the establishment of demonstration plots in collaboration with input companies and provide technical training to FSCs, and farmers on CSA/GAP, and PHM leveraging on public and private sector partners facilitating and supporting market linkages and aggregation via the FSC model.

KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Project Implementation

- Plan and ensure all project outputs, as listed in the project documents, are effectively achieved.
- Link and coordinate service providers, both public and private sector partners with FSCs, and farmers, and facilitate access to demand-driven products, services (aggregated), and information, through B2B meetings at district and village levels, FSC and farmer outreach programs, and market activation campaigns (field days)
- Conduct a high-level rapid assessment of services and products demanded by smallholders and establish critical demand (quantitative) that will inform FSC decision-making.
- Build capacity of FSCs (sales agronomists and extension officers) through TOTs on CSA/GAP/ PHM
- Deliver demand-driven advisory services through the establishment of demonstration plots in collaboration with input companies and training of FSC, farmers on CSA/GAP, and PHM leveraging on public and private sector partners
- Development and dissemination of agronomic and other communication/visibility materials (CSA/GAP, PHM, mechanization)
- Organize training and sensitization meetings (workshop) on new or piloted interventions/innovations (Agroforestry Spraying service providers, QDS production)
- Training and demonstration activities (ex. Irrigation practices SRI, soil and water conservation- water retaining/harvesting, agroforestry, ISFM, IPM)
- Develop and validate business cases on mechanization, agroforestry, and QDS
- Support the scale-up and documentation of aggregation models, farmer outreach, and aggregation whilst sensitizing on standards, quality assurance
- Conduct and disseminate market intelligence on market prices, crops demanded, offtakers, logistics, finance, etc. to FSCs for decision-making.
- Coordinate linkage meetings (B2Bs and B2C)) and scale up engagement between off-takers/financial institutions/logistics service providers on different offerings to FSCs and farmers.
- Coordinate and monitor output aggregation and sales and identify challenges and best practices for soya bean, maize, beans, sunflower and rice.
- Development of CSA training materials/info graphs and documentaries
- Promotion of agroforestry trees (woodlots/fallows/fodder banks), establishment of tree nurseries and supporting commercialization
- Conduct mechanization field days'/service clinics with Mechanization

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- suppliers/distributers to promote assortment of climate smart implements rippers, sub soilers and mechanization tools (power tillers etc)
- Conduct a capacity needs assessment/capacity diagnostics and determine and assess gaps in knowledge, skills, and capacities to effectively implement the plan outcomes of the project.
- Support provision of soil testing, spraying and QDS to SHF
- Strengthen the technical and business acumen of the SMEs, FOs, AMCOS, agrodealers, and entrepreneurs in collaboration with private sector actors and BDS providers.
- Facilitate recruitment and registration of farmers whilst capturing critical data on farmer profiles, commodities and acres under production, yield estimates and forecasts, farm management and good agriculture practices, etc.
- Conduct field-level farmer outreach and mobilization to raise awareness of project activities

Monitoring and Reporting

- Support the Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning (MEL) team in acquiring high level of good quality data related to the FSC.
- Work closely with the Project Coordinator (PC) and Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning (MEL) team to ensure data collection tools at the FSC level are aligned to the project's M&E activity plan and indicators.
- Performing regular monitoring and providing updates to donor on the services provided by FCSs (e.g, improved seeds sold, post-harvest technology provision, aggregation and marketing, mechanization services delivered etc);
- Collaborate with the team to develop the activities work plan and consolidate monthly, and quarterly reports, and related donor reports and ensure timely submission to the project coordinator based on the agreed format and according to organisational guidelines and deadlines
- Document case studies and success stories
- With support from the MEL team, participate in community feedback sessions and document lessons for improving project delivery.
